

**Classrooms at New College of Florida
Fall 2007**

Caples Fine Arts (CFA).

CFA 211: Seminar-style multiple tables and chairs arranged in a circle. Mounted digital projector, speakers, mini-Mac setup, slide projector on a cart, center-mounted projection screen, chalk board. Seats for 20 students.

CFA 212: Tablet armchairs, mounted digital projector, VHS/DVD, PC, center-mounted projection screen, overhead projector, TV on media cart and Radio Shack boom box in closet. Seats for 25 students.

College Hall (CHL). Each of these rooms has a Media Cart consisting of a PC and VHS/DVD player connected to an LCD projector.

CHL 214: Long, narrow seminar table, 20 chairs. Screen mounted in the corner. Green chalk board. Elmo.

CHL 215: Movable small tables and 15 chairs. Chalk board and movable white board. Projection screen mounted above the middle of the black chalk board. Overhead projector.

CHL 221: 38 tablet armchairs, chalk board, wall-mounted TV, VHS/DVD player.

CHL 224: 20 tablet armchairs, chalk board and white board, wall-mounted TV, VHS/DVD player

Music Room: Media Cart, piano, VHS/DVD player, screen mounted over west windows.

HCL 004: Currently off-line and serving as a storage space

HCL 005: LCD projector and 25 PC stations.

HCL 007: Tablet armchair seating for up to 59 students. It looked as if the room includes fewer seats than that.

HCL 008 (Teaching Auditorium): Projection booth, PC and VHS/DVD player, seating for 112 students, black chalk board.

Library (LBR). Each of these classrooms has an LCD projector mounted from the ceiling connected to a PC and VHS/DVD player.

LBR 152: Tablet armchairs, 40 seats, VHS/DVD, Elmo projector, overhead projector

LBR 154: Small tables, 36 seats, overhead projector, VHS/DVD

LBR 156: Small tables, 45 seats

LBR 209: (Enter through interior of library) Small tables, 30 seats, movable chalkboard, slide projector with carousel

LBR 248: Small tables, 45 seats, Elmo projector, overhead projector, TV, VHS/DVD player

LBR 250: Small tables, 45 seats, TV, VHS/DVD player

LBR 252: Small tables, 58 seats, Overhead projector, VHS/DVD player

PMA 213: Table armchairs, 28 seats, ceiling-mounted LCD projector, overhead projector, VHS/DVD

PMC 219: Seminar table, 25 seats, TV (no projectors)

PME 213: Seminar table, 15 seats, Media cart with projector, white board

PME 219: Seminar table, 26 seats

PME 223: Little, seminar-like room, 10 seats, cart with LCD projector and computer, overhead projector, TV

CFA 213: One station for music printing

HCL 005: 25 stations

HCL 006: Mac lab
